- Take the New Jersey Turnpike to Exit 7A.
- Bear LEFT onto the ramp towards I-195 West towards Trenton.
- Take I-195 West for 1 exit.
- At I-195 Exit 5B, take the ramp RIGHT onto US-130 towards North/New Brunswick.
- Bear RIGHT and proceed to less than 1/4 of a mile. Stay in the RIGHT hand lane.
- Make a RIGHT at the "Horizon Center North" sign onto AAA Drive. Continue to follow the curvature of the road around to your RIGHT.
- The HCANJ Building is on this curve, on the left — 4 AAA Drive. The HCANJ Executive Office is located on the second floor.
