Legislative activity included:

A15 – Sponsors: Prieto (D32); Wisniewski (D19); Schaer (D36); Tucker (D28); Oliver (D34); Wimberly (D35)

Summary: Raises minimum wage rate to \$10.10, makes further increases over a four-year period, and maintains annual cost of living increases. 05/26/2016—Passed in Assembly 42-31-1; 06/23/2016—Substituted for S-15. Motion to amend on Senate floor. Motion to table bill 21-16. Passed in Senate and sent to Governor 21-18. 09/08/16 – Governor's veto received in the Assembly. Position: Oppose. *Democrats have vowed to reintroduce as a constitutional amendment to be voted on in 2017.*

A1641 – Sponsors: Schaer (D36); Jimenez (D32); Wimberly (D35); Caride (D36) +6 Summary: Requires electric public utilities to provide priority power restoration to certain medical facilities, assisted living facilities, and nursing homes.

History: 01/27/2016—Introduced Assembly Homeland Security & State Preparedness Comm. 05/19/2016 Reported out of committee, 2nd reading in Assembly. Scheduled: 09/15/2016—Assembly Voting Session.

Position: Support
